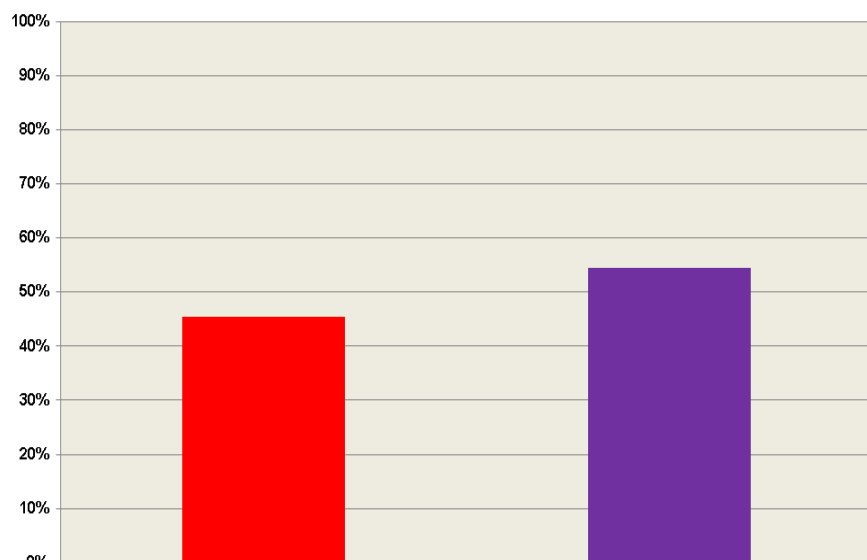
What do Black Asian and Minority Ethnic young Londoners think the priorities should be for London's Mayor?



225 Young People completed an on-line survey

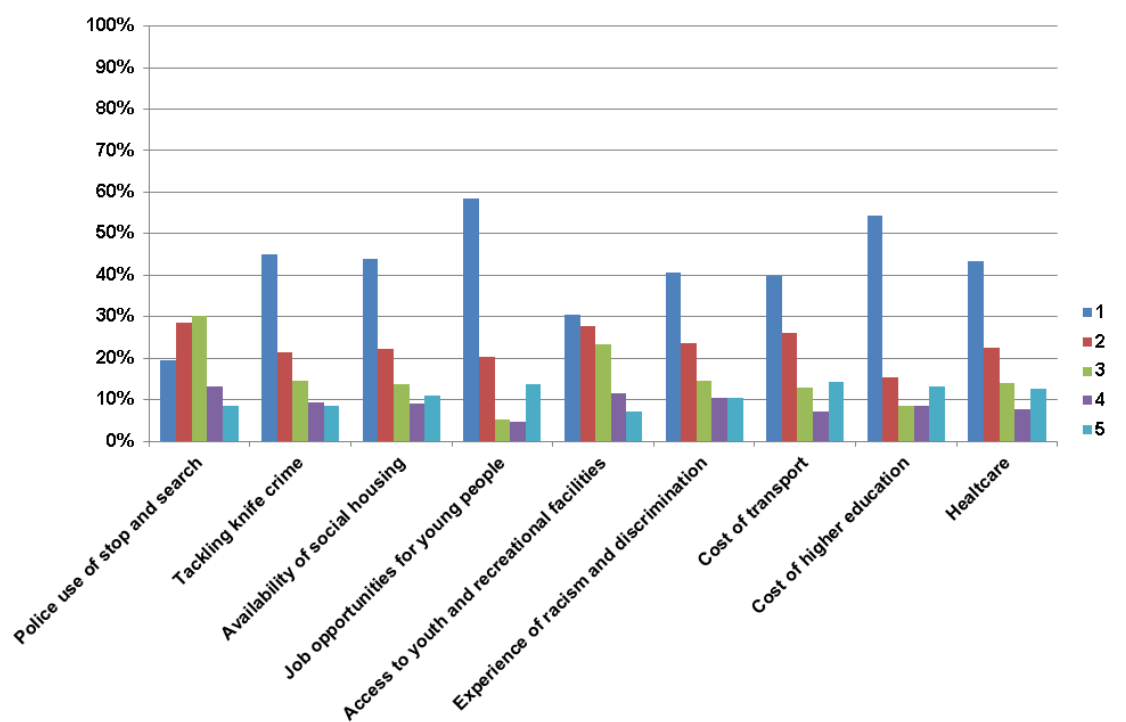
They were asked:
